



PREVAILING WAGE / DIR DETERMINATION WEBSITE LINK

- The first bid advertisement date establishes which Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) determination to use for each work classification you assign to this project.
 - If the project's bid advertisement is first advertised between March 4 and September 1 of the current year (March 3 in leap years), contractors must refer to the "current" Determination, which ends in "- 1" (e.g. 2010-1).
 - If the project's bid advertisement is first advertised between September 2 and March 3 of the year (March 2 in leap years), contractors must refer to the Determination, which ends in "- 2" (e.g. 2010-2).
- NOTE: Contractors are held responsible for any/all increases to the prevailing wages. If you see a double asterisk after the determination expiration date (**) then there will be an increase to the prevailing wages.
